This 2-day course will provide an overview of current treatment approaches used to address frequently seen problems in the field of stroke rehabilitation.

- Analysis of movement and demonstration of practical hands-on treatment strategies.
- Current information on therapies such as constraint induced movement therapy (CIMT), visual mirror feedback and motor imagery
- Review of orthoses and neuro-visual rehab.
- Underlying principles behind current approaches to neuro-rehabilitation
- Impact of sensory and visual-spatial deficits on movement and rehabilitation
- Importance of addressing cardiovascular re-conditioning in persons with stroke
