HOW WE HELP >

Open Doors for Lanark Children and Youth is an accredited child and youth mental health centre. Our staff are members of professional colleges - Social Work, Psychotherapy and ECE. All have dedicated their education and training to working with children and families.

Our staff treat all people with respect and dignity, regardless of race, religion, culture or sexual orientation. They believe all children and youth have strengths and that we need to understand children and youth within the context of their whole world.

We provide free counselling and parent support. Our services are confidential and easily accessible with offices in Carleton Place, Smiths Falls and Perth. Our Counsellors support many of the high schools in Lanark County.






WHO WE SERVE >

Open Doors provides mental health services to Lanark County's children and youth up to their 18th birthday.

No professional referral is required and children over the age of 12 can self-refer. Youth in school can access the School Based program until they are 21. Some of the children and youth who come to Open Doors are having difficulty with behaviour or emotions while others are experiencing mental health problems



OPEN DOOR SERVICES >

QUICK RESPONSE

When you contact Open Doors for Lanark Children and Youth, our Access Service will work with you to develop a plan that responds to your needs and makes sense to you.

BRIEF SERVICES

If it is a good fit, you can access our Brief Servcies. Sometimes all that is required is one to four sessions with a Counsellor.

SCHOOL BASED COUNSELLING

Any youth attending a high school in Lanark County can access Brief Services onsite in their high school.

COUNSELLING

Our Counsellors work with individuals, families and groups using a variety of evidence informed practises.

WALK IN

No appointment necessary - walk in single session support. Mondays 1-8pm in Smiths Falls, Tuesdays - 9:30-4:30 in Perth, Wednesdays 9:30-5:30 in Carleton Place.

GROUP SERVICES

Youth Engagement and Peer to Peer Group (every 2nd Wednesday 4-6pm in Carleton Place), additional group services please contact your local office.

YOUTH IN TRANSITION

Transitional Aged Youth (16-24) can connect through taylanark@youthhab.ca

FAMILY RESOURCE TEAM

The Family Resource Team members coach, model and educate parents on how best to manage and support their children.

YOUTH INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT

The Youth Intensive Case Management Counsellor works with a small number of youth who are experiencing significant difficulties at home, at school and sometimes with the law. Our Youth Intensive Case Management Counsellor is very flexible in finding ways to engage youth in positive outcomes.

ACCESS TO SPECIALISED SERVICES

We work closely with the Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario, the Royal Ottawa Mental Health Centre and Kingston General Hospital. These three hospitals have a range of psychiatric services and we link with their services. In some cases, we are able to provide access to these services on site, in person or through video link.
