

Vascular Health Resources

The goal of this initiative is to provide a user-friendly online resource for health professionals and health care consumers in their efforts to improve vascular health and system navigation.

<u>Vascular diseases</u> is a term for a wide range of diseases that affect the vascular or blood vessel systems of your body. They can include certain heart diseases such as coronary artery disease, kidney disease, stroke, diabetes and dementia. These diseases are different but are linked by common risk factors such as hypertension, physical inactivity and poor nutrition. This directory helps users navigate the services available for reducing their risk, managing vascular diseases, and living with the disease.
