Meals on Wheels

Dedicated volunteers deliver hot, nutritious noon meals to your home. Many therapeutic diets can be accommodated. Meals are available up to four times a week. Nominal fees apply.

Frozen Meals

A selection of delicious entrees prepared by Apetito are also available for pick-up or delivery.

Escorted Transportation

Friendly, skilled volunteer drivers use their own vehicle to provide safe, escorted rides to medical, dental, or therapy appointments. Rides may be long distance or local. Individuals who qualify for this service are responsible for cost recovery for the volunteer driver.

Home Help & Home Maintenance

A support service that arranges for a brokered worker or local company to provide home maintenance and repair or provide home helpers to assist with household activities. Fees vary and are arranged between the worker and client.

Activity Program
