Our Services

Your personalized rehabilitation plan might include one or more of these services:

Low vision services

If you have low vision, learning to use the sight you have left can be life-changing.
We can:

- Provide a functional vision assessment
- Teach you to use contrast and lighting to maximize your eyesight
- Help you use sight-enhancing devices like specialty magnifiers

Essential skills for daily living

After you lose your sight, everyday tasks can pose new challenges. We can:

- Show you safe ways to cook meals, use household appliances and more
- Teach you to label medication, identify money and organize your home
- Show you how to use large-print, braille and audio products, and assistive technology in your day-to-day routine

Travel and mobility instruction

Learning to travel independently with vision loss is an essential skill. We can:

- Show you guiding techniques for walking with a sighted person
- Help you use your remaining vision and other senses to move safely
- Teach you how to use a white cane or other mobility tools
- Help you navigate your community on foot and by public transit

Services for children and families


Our services help pre-school and school-aged children with vision loss develop the skills they need to grow into confident and successful adults. We can:
